Interested parties/stakeholders from the clinical and technical communities are welcome and encouraged to join and participate in the activities of this WG.

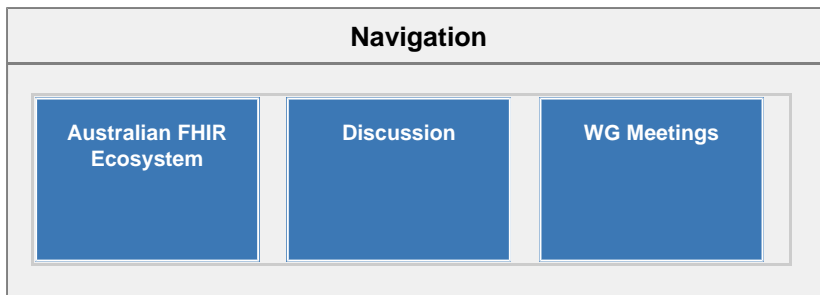
